Job Description for Coaches

It is expected that all coaches appointed by Redditch Hockey Club will follow the below guidelines and requirements at all times. Coaches should remember that they are representing Redditch Hockey Club whether they are coaching or helping at Redditch or any other venue and should act accordingly.

- Work to Improve Stick Skills, including individual and team exercises.
- Work to improve knowledge of game and rules.
- Inspire players to achieve the best they can for themselves and the club.
- Work to improve team playing skills and therefore team performances.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Work to improve goal keeping skills.
- Promote and encourage the benefits of external fitness options.
- Abide by the code of conduct for coaches
- Encourage others to abide by relevant the code of conduct.
- Promote regular dialogue with Child Protection Officer
- Promote regular dialogue with Junior Development Office
- Support players' involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Promote team and club camaraderie.
- Encourage players to lead others and inspire each other.
- Encourage players to work towards coaching and umpiring qualifications.
- Do not film or photograph any training sessions or matches without prior approval of the session organiser.
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibitive substances
- Ensure you always have access to a phone, first aid kit and the emergency and health details of the people you are coaching.
