Code of Conduct for Spectators

Spectators can have a big influence on the manner in which the clubs players conduct themselves. It is therefore very important that all spectators set an example in terms of their conduct and expect all members of the club to follow that example.

- Encourage players to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help players to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force anyone to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support players' involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Do not film or photograph any training sessions or matches without prior approval of the session organiser.
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibitive substances.
- Discipline within the club is taken very seriously and will be dealt with by the Club Disciplinary Officer and in accordance with the club constitution.
